

PUNCHING SYSTEM

The SPORTident AIR+ system will be used with all controls on BEACON mode. SIAC cards can register the control from +- 40cm.

You can use your own SPORTident, or you can rent one from the organisation.

TIME

Please keep in mind, the time will change to winter time between 26th and 27th.

FIRST AID

There is a first aid tent incl. defibrillator at the competition centre.

FOOD & DRINKS

Both days during the competition we will offer some food and drinks.

TRANSPORT

There is no organised transport for the event.

EXTRA CLOTHES

There is no separate transport of clothing from start to event area. The distance between Start and Finish is about 300 meters.

PRICES

First three athletes of each class will receive a price. The result is calculated as total of the two races.

SUMMARY OF ENTRIES

Until now, we have entries from 400 people from 20 different countries.

In the ELITE classes we have 42 runners in the men's class and 18 in the women's class.

Categories W/M10, W/M10 accompanied, W/M12, short difficult and long difficult have open starting times between 12:30 and 14:30.

RESULTS

Final results are displayed at the arena, and live results can be followed at <u>Helga-o.com</u>.

After the event the results will be available at the event homepage.

COMPLAINTS

A complaint must be made in writing as soon as possible and given to the Event Office in the Competition Centre. A complaint form from the event should be used and are available at the Event Office. Complaints should be handed in no longer than 15 minutes after the publication of the final results.

The organisation can make a decision about the complaint. A protest may be made against the organisers decision. The protest must be written and has to be handed in at the Event Office no longer than 15 minutes after the decision about the complaint.

Previous maps of the race area of both days can be found on the event website. It is not allowed to bring these maps to the arena on the day (neither digitally nor in printed). In case an athlete is seen with a previous map of the area, it can lead to a disqualification.

CLASSES

Men Elite (M21 E), Women Elite (W21 E)

There are no age restrictions for the Elite category.

Other categories: W/M: 10, 10 accompanied, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 21, 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, W75+, M80, kids' course

Open categories: short easy, middle medium, short difficult and long difficult

Categories W18 and W20 are combined.

WINNER TIMES

The winner times for the WRE middle distance are: 30-35min

REGISTRATION AND BIB NUMBERS

All WRE athletes must identify themselves at the Competition Centre with a valid ID. WRE athletes must wear bib numbers, which they receive during the registration.

For runners in other classes, it is not necessary to register at the competition centre. The Bib numbers are only for WRE classes.



CONTROL DESCRIPTIONS

Separate control descriptions are available at start.

START PROCEDURE

All WRE participants in D21 (WOMEN) and H21 (MEN) start at at separate block in the start area, which is next to the start area for other classes.



It is the responsibility of the runner to clear the SPORTIdent.

Runners must punch the start control at the start.

Runners starting too late must contact the start staff, who will be helpful with the start process.

FINISH

Finish control is used to register the finish time.

TERRAIN

Old maps of both areas can be found on the event website.

SATURDAY October 26: Kootwijkerzand

Large sand drift area surrounded with mixed forest and small relief. Sand drifts are coloured as in the example

map below.

Special mapping

Nr 419 Prominent vegetation feature (P) = Only trees and tree trunks of > 2 m are drawn.

Benches in the terrain are **not** visible on the map.

Courses

No road crossing.

There is a permission to use the complete terrain and map drawings are to be followed (these rule out the cords and restriction signs on the terrain).

Parking to Competition Centre: <500m Competition centre to start: 350m Finish to competition centre: 250m

SUNDAY October 27: Arnhemse Heide

Open terrain with heath and (high) grass, mixed forest with many small details.



Special mapping

Nr 419 Prominent vegetation feature (P) = Only trees and tree trunks of > 2 m are drawn.

Due to intensive use of the area, there are many small paths which are not drawn on the map.

In the forest area in the middle, there is lots of damage on the ground which is drawn as difficult ground to run.

Courses

There is a mandatory passage on the course which is indicated in the map.
